Description

Established in 2016, the Kawartha Potters Guild Bursary encourages students to develop an appreciation for the ceramic arts. The Kawartha Potters Guild is committed to making quality ceramic arts education accessible to all; regardless of age, culture, gender, ability, or financial circumstances.

If you qualify as a low or middle income family (based on CRA standards), you may be eligible for full or partial bursaries.

The following documents **MUST** be included in the application package:

- Proof of income for all adult members in your household (e.g., notice of assessment or documentation for government assistance). If applicable, provide a letter to support your application where proof of income may not reflect current circumstances.
- This application form and desired program Registration Form
- Applicable \$25 co-payment (\$25 per course, summer camp, or other program)
- Applicant's Personal Statement (see below)

Please complete one application per student.

Eligibility

To be considered for a bursary, candidates must show proof of financial need as well as interest in the ceramic arts.

Deadlines

Applications must be received four (4) weeks prior to the start of the session of choice. All dates are available through the KPG website.
